ASCIA Action Plan for Allergic Reactions 2023 - What's New?

ASCIA has developed a new 2023 version of the green **ASCIA Action Plan for Allergic Reactions**, which is available from June 2023 onwards. The changes have been made to improve ease of use and are consistent with the changes made to the red ASCIA Action Plans for Anaphylaxis. This is the first major formatting change in 20 years, since ASCIA Action Plans for Anaphylaxis were first introduced in 2003.
